

**Keynote Speaker - Chief Commissioner Barbara Hall**

Barbara Hall was appointed Chief Commissioner of the Ontario Human Rights Commission on November 28, 2005, after more than 30 years as a community worker, lawyer and municipal politician. She served three terms as a city councillor from 1985 on and as Toronto's mayor from 1994 to 1997.

Ms Hall has extensive experience on non-profit boards and committees, and has a strong record of bringing diverse groups together to build safe and strong communities.

**Keynote Speaker - Deena Ladd**

Deena Ladd has been working to improve wages and working conditions for workers of colour, low-wage workers, women, and immigrant workers for the past twenty years. She was an organizer with the International Ladies Garment Workers Union (now known as UNITE) for seven years; and she has developed and taught courses, workshops, and training sessions for various federations of labour, unions, and community organizations. Currently, Deena is the coordinator of the Worker's Action Centre which works with predominantly low-waged immigrant workers and workers of colour in precarious jobs.

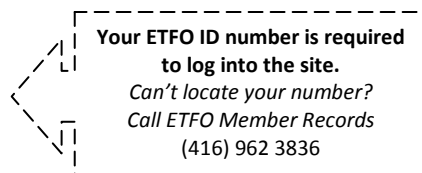
